We are going to be carrying out the final statutory pre-application public events as part of the formal PAN (Proposal of Application Notice) process on our proposed Coire Glas switching station and Loch Lundie substation.

The proposed developments are an integral part of the Coire Glas Connection project to connect the Coire Glas Pumped Hydro Scheme. This Scheme will be the first large-scale pumped storage scheme to be developed in the UK for more than 30 years and supports the UK target towards a net-zero carbon energy system by 2050.

These drop-in information sharing events will be an opportunity to view our final proposals, ask any questions and find out how feedback from our previous consultations have been implemented into the design development of our proposals ahead of submission of the planning applications.
