

## **TECHNICAL APPENDIX 11.3: OUTER STUDY AREA GAZETTEER OF DESIGNATED HERITAGE ASSETS**

This Technical Appendix provides details on the heritage assets recorded in the Outer Study Area<sup>1</sup> together with an assessment of their heritage sensitivity and of the potential effects of the Proposed Development on their setting.
