Shin Substation

Scottish Hydro Electric Transmission plc operates under licence and is responsible for maintaining and investing in the electricity transmission network in the north of Scotland. A principal responsibility includes the ongoing maintenance and upkeep of existing assets to ensure they meet industry regulations and can be operated both safely and efficiently.

We will be commencing work at the Shin Substation with the replacement of three circuit breakers from September 2020 to February 2021, the project will take approximately 5 months to complete. We have developed the project methodology and programme of works to ensure the work can be completed safely and not cause any interruption to the local communities' electricity supply.

The circuit breakers to be installed are Siemens Clean Air Circuit Breakers and will go towards helping the UK and Scottish Government to achieve net zero emissions.

I have included the current high-level programme of the work to be undertaken during this period. (these dates may be subject to change)

Deliveries to site, plant and equipment

w/c 12 September 2020

Soil Resistivity Survey

W/c 5 October 2020

Establish site set up, welfare cabins to site, in line with

COVID – 19 restrictions/guidelines

W/c 12 October to February 2021 Removal of existing and Installation of new circuit breakers

The work being carried out at Shin Substation is being undertaken during an outage and while we would seek to avoid where ever possible working at the weekends or beyond 19:00 this may be necessary to complete a critical piece of work.
