# **Skye Reinforcement Project Additional Information Submission**

The following additional information is submitted for the above application.

#### **Derogation Case**

A Derogation Case is submitted in relation to Section 3 (Broadford to Kyle Rhea) of the Skye Reinforcement Project. The details of the compensatory measures are to be the subject of a separate document to follow in due course. However, to assist the Scottish Ministers, the Derogation Case provides an outline of possible compensatory measured that can be taken forward in a compensation plan.

# **Peat Probing**

As detailed in SEPA's consultation response dated 10<sup>th</sup> January, we enclose the results of the peat probing investigation undertaken between 23<sup>rd</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of January 2023. This was carried out within Section 4 and 5 of the Proposed Development, within the locations and frequency as agreed with SEPA.

The results of the peat probing exercise are detailed in the Peat Depth and Occurrence: Sections 4 and 5 report.

This shows peat depths of more than 1m were present at 7 tower locations within Sections 4 and 5 of the project. Possible micro-siting opportunities within the limit of deviation are detailed within the report, where it presents opportunities to avoid areas of deeper peat, during the construction phase.

#### EIA Volume 2, Chapter 9 - Forestry Clarification

We identified some inaccuracies in the figures within the forestry chapter of the EIA (Volume 2, Chapter 9) and associated appendices. The "Additional Information Forestry Clarifications"
