STAND WITH UKRAINE

Solidarity shown with war-ravaged country after White House 'schoolyard bully' clash

People across Perthshire have been urged to boost ongoing efforts to send vital supplies to war-torn Ukraine after President Trump dramatically pulled US aid.

One of Scotland's leading forces of support, Tayside and Strathearn Help for Ukraine (TASH4Ukraine), is preparing to send its 100th 40ft lorry-full of food and medicine.

Volunteers are now calling on local people to help them step up in the wake of US President Trump's snub, which they fear will only strengthen Putin's assault.

Vice-chair Deborah Ovens said: "We have to give Ukraine a clear and strong message that people here in Scotland are still behind them by giving what they can."

Strathallan councillor Steven Carr (top, left), who was made an MBE for his heroic work with the charity he founded, Dnipro Kids, rallied councillors to support Ukraine at a council meeting this week.

He ditched his suit in solidarity with President Volodymyr Zelenskyy who was rounded on by President Trump and Vice President JD Vance in a volatile showdown last week.

Cllr Carr called them "schoolyard bullies".

£10m Lidl store gets green light

Councillors have granted Lidl permission to invest £10 million to build a second Perth store and create up to 40 jobs.

Rejecting officers' recommendations to refuse the application, the majority of councillors voted in favour of the Crieff Road development to give residents "more choice".

Lidl's plans to build a supermarket on the other side of McDiarmid Park from Tesco - the supermarket giant was the only objector - had strong support from the local community.

Perth and Kinross Council's Planning and Placemaking Committee approved plans for a 1,949m² store with 103 parking spaces, by nine votes to two.

CONTROVERSIAL PLAN IS REJECTED

NO BATTERY PLANT ON OLD BATTLEFIELD

Councillors have unanimously refused plans for a battery storage plant on a former battlefield site at Tibbermore.

Manchester-based Ylem (BESS) North Ltd submitted plans to Perth and Kinross Council (PKC) for a 50MW energy storage facility with 24 battery storage containers

Unanimous decision to refuse Tibbermore proposal

on land 260m South West of Taigh An Struith, Tibbermore near Perth.

The local authority received 20 letters of objection, including an objection from Methven and District Community

Council.

Heritage body Perth and Kinross Heritage Trust (PKHT) previously said the development

would have an "irreversible negative impact" on the battlefield site,

considered to have regional, and potentially, national significance.

The site lies within the boundary of Historic Environment Scotland's Inventory of Historic Battlefields.

It is thought that 300 Covenanters killed in the 1644 Battle of Tippermuir are buried

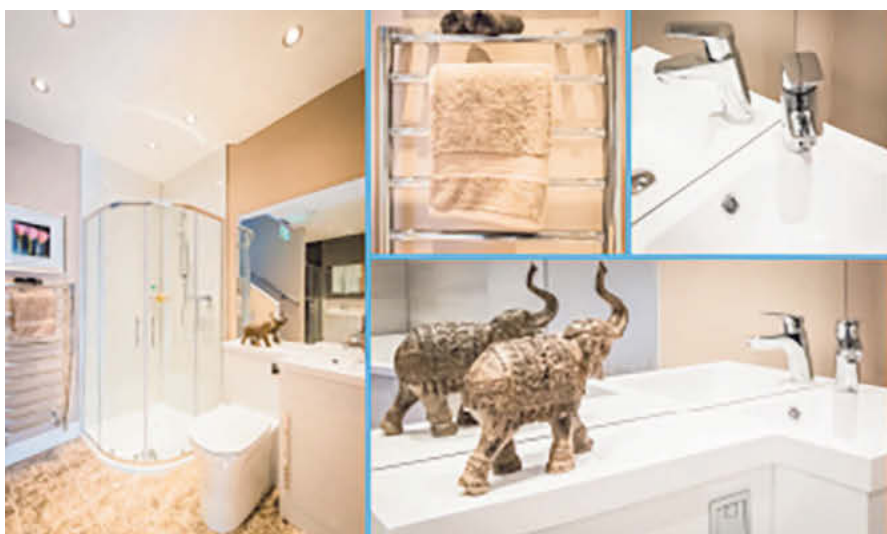
in Tibbermore churchyard, but no mass grave has ever been found.

The council's own Development Plan Team objected to the plans due to concerns about its impact on the green landscape.

Planning permission was unanimously refused.
