Coire Glas Connection Project – Loch Lundie Substation

About the project

The Coire Glas connection project is required to connect the Coire Glas Pumped Hydro Scheme. A new 400kV substation, switching station and overhead line are required to connect the Scheme. The PAN process is a key first step in the Town and Country planning process for this substation and starts a 12-week consultation period for feedback and comments.

Why we are consulting again

Following further consultation with the landowner, Forestry Land Scotland (FLS) we will be presenting a newly revised Red Line boundary area for the already proposed Loch Lundie substation to gather your feedback. This new boundary area includes suitable areas to develop the Peat Management Plan agreed with FLS. During this drop-in public event you will be able to view project information about our proposals and there will be an opportunity to discuss these and share feedback with our project team.

Please note: We have held a separate PAC event for the proposed Coire Glas switching station and overhead line. We intend to hold final pre-application consultation events in the Autumn where we will be sharing project information and feedback on all 3 elements of this connection project – proposed Loch Lundie substation, Switching station and overhead line.

Glengarry Community Hall in Invergarry on 20th August from 3pm-7pm.
