

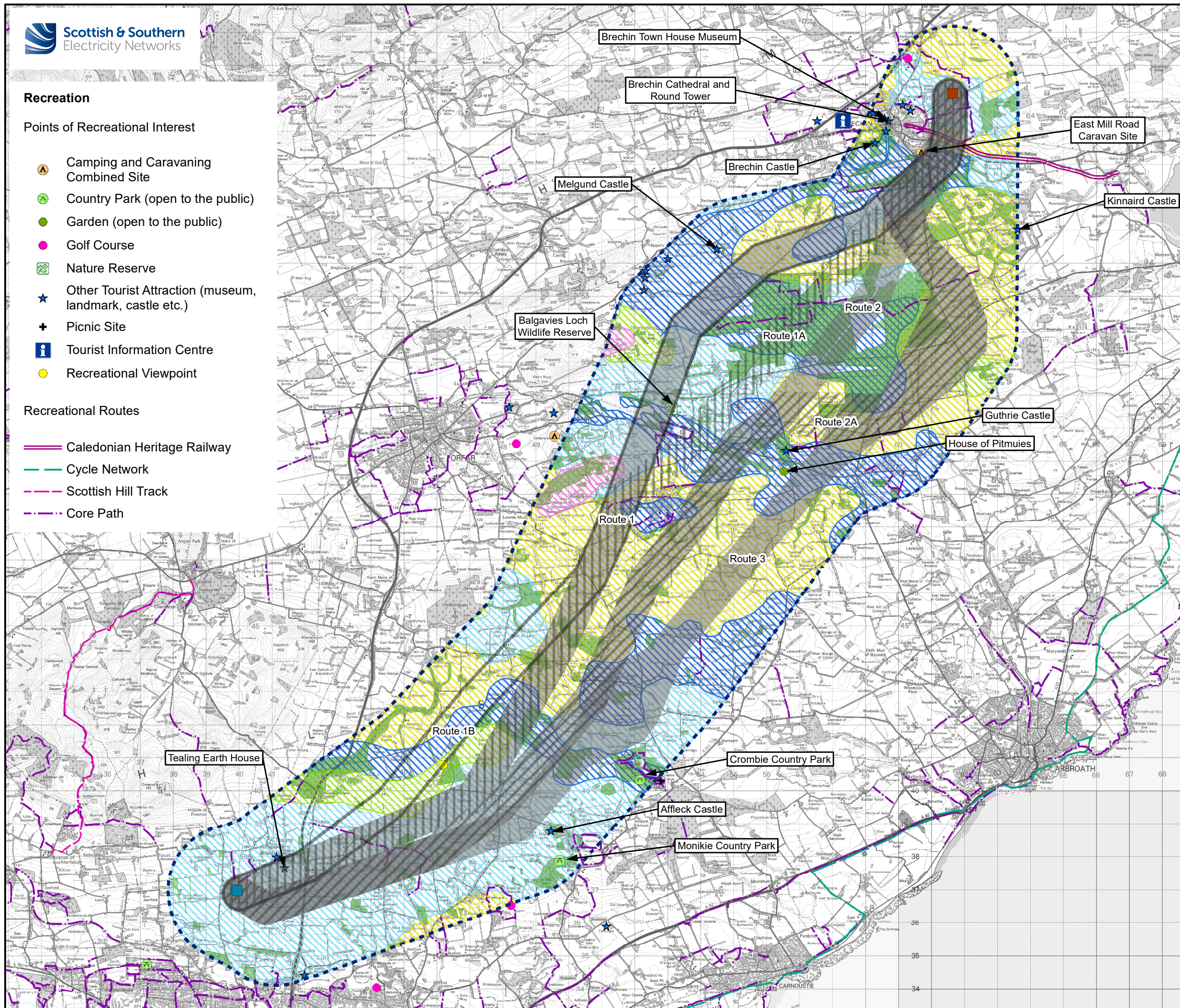

Landuse

- 2 - Land Capable of producing a wide range of crops
- 3.1 - Land capable of producing consistently high yields of a narrow range of crops and/ or moderate yields of a wider range
- 3.2 - Land capable of average production though high yields of barley, oats and grass can be obtained. Grass leys are common
- 4.1 - Capable of producing a narrow range of crops
- 4.2 - Limited potential for producing other crops
- 5.1 - Land capable of use as improved grassland. Few problems with pasture establishment and maintenance and potential high yields
