In recognition of feedback received from our previous consultations held in April this year plans have been developed for the reinforcement works required at Errochty substation and SSEN Transmission are pleased to be hosting a face to face public consultation feedback event to present the updated design and gain views and feedback on our updated proposals to facilitate the installation of two new 90MVA 132/33kV transformers, along with appropriate 132kV and 33kV switchgear to create a new Grid Supply Point (GSP) adjacent to the existing Errochty 132kV substation in Tummel Bridge.
