



Glendye Wind Farm Connection

Final Pre-Application Consultation (PAC) Events

We are hosting public consultation feedback events for our proposed Glendye Wind Farm Connection project. These events conclude the Pre-Application Consultation (PAC) process for the consent application that will be submitted under section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989.

The Glendye Wind Farm has received Section 36 consent, and we have a legal requirement to connect the development to the transmission network. To facilitate this, we are proposing to construct a new 20km 132kV overhead line (OHL) using steel trident poles, from the substation at the wind farm approximately 8km North West of Fettercairn, to the existing Fetteresso substation 7km west of Stonehaven.

We will be sharing our proposed alignment of the overhead line, including details on how this decision was taken. This will be presented on maps and visualisations with booklets and handouts available for attendees and digital versions available to download on our project webpage.

Interested parties can attend our drop-in events to discuss our plans with the project team and share your thoughts on the final alignment ahead of our application for Section 37 consent.
