Inveraray – Crossaig Project

Firetower Trail Closure

Achnabreac

SSEN Transmission have been working closely with Forestry and Land Scotland to ensure outdoor forestry users keep safe during the construction of the Inveraray to Crossaig project.

From early January, construction vehicles transporting stone and concrete for the creation of access tracks and the delivery of materials to site will be utilising the forest road adjacent to the A816, where Forestry and Land Scotland's Firetower Trail is located.

Due to the volume of construction traffic anticipated during the first half of 2020, the Firetower Trail will require to be closed during this time.

Access to the three walking trails around the Forestry and Land Scotland car park at Achnabreac will however remain open. Please note that there will be an increase in work vehicles on the main forest road access to the lower and upper car parks as well as the forest road section of the Cup and Ring Trail.

There will be safety signage implemented at the area and we thank recreational users in advance for adhering to this signage and apologise for any inconvenience which may be caused.
