1. DESIGNATED HERITAGE ASSETS IN THE OUTER STUDY AREA

- 1.1.1 Designated heritage assets within the Outer Study Area are set out in **Table 10.7.1: Designated Heritage Assets within the Outer Study Area** below. Designated heritage assets highlighted in light blue within the table are considered to have a wider landscape setting and are especially sensitive to change on their setting, and have been further assessed in detail, see **Volume 5, Appendix 10.10: Detailed Assessment of Designated Heritage Assets in the Outer Study Area**.
- 1.1.2 Designated heritage assets specifically requested by HES, ACAS or Aberdeenshire Built Heritage Officer (see **Volume 5, Appendix 10.2: Cultural Heritage Consultation Responses** for details) have also been further assessed in detail and are included in **Volume 5, Appendix 10.10: Detailed Assessment of Designated Heritage Assets in the Outer Study Area**.
- 1.1.3 The designated heritage assets have been organised by designation type (ie Scheduled Monuments, Listed Buildings, Inventory Garden and Designed Landscapes, and Conservation Areas) from south to north along the Kintore to Tealing 400 kV Overhead Line (OHL) ('the Proposed Development') and by Sections A-F.
- 1.1.4 Designated heritage assets that lie within urban settings or townscapes, and which have been scoped out of the assessment are provided in **Volume 5, Appendix 10.8: Listed Buildings in Conservation Areas and Townscapes**. Where specific heritage assets that lie within townscapes have been raised by statutory consultees as requiring consideration these have been included within the assessment.
