

Netherton Hub

Pre-application consultation event

We are holding statutory pre-application consultation events for our proposed Netherton Hub project. The pre-application process is a key first step in the Town and Country Planning process for National Development planning applications.

To support the growth in renewable developments across the north of Scotland, which are supporting the country's drive towards Net Zero, investment in our network infrastructure is needed to connect this power and transport it to areas of demand.

The Netherton Hub is a strategic development proposed near Longside to the west of Peterhead, comprising of two substations (400kV and 132kV), an HVDC switching station, two HVDC converter stations and a warehouse and operations base.

During our consultation event you will be able to view information about our proposed plans for the Netherton Hub, meet the project team, ask questions and share feedback ahead of our second public event in late May.

Also at the event will be representatives from the proposed new 400kV Beauly-Peterhead overhead line that will connect in to the Netherton Hub.
