What is happening?

Scottish and Southern Electricity Networks Transmission (SSEN-T) are holding a virtual consultation exhibition to gather your views and feedback on our proposals for transformer replacement works required at Sloy Power Station. In lieu of being able to hold face-to-face public consultation in the local area we are hosting a virtual online consultation exhibition to provide detail about this proposed project.

What are we consulting on?

We are developing plans to replace four transformers and associated equipment due to ageing and consequent deterioration in their condition which poses a risk of multiple unit failure.
