
V4b Figure 7-89a Viewpoint 89: Cnoc Croit

Follow the wooden sign for Ord Hill and go through the gate ahead into Corry Wood and follow the forestry track as it climbs gently and bends to the right.








V4b Figure 7-89b(i) **Viewpoint 89: Cnoc Croit** View Direction: 315.5°


