

Tomchrasky Wind Farm Connection

Alignment options consultation events

Following our route consultation events held in October 2024 we are pleased to announce the next round of consultation events for our proposed Tomchrasky wind farm connection project.

Subject to planning consent, SSEN Transmission are required to connect the Tomchrasky wind farm to the transmission network.

To facilitate this, we are proposing to construct a new single circuit 132kV overhead line from the Tomchrasky wind farm 132kV substation to the new proposed Bingally substation, for a distance of approximately 22 kilometers.

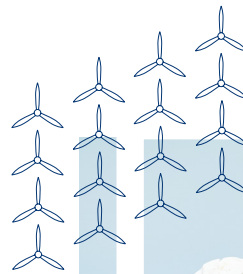

The consultation event at Cannich Hall on **Monday 25 August 2025** will be held alongside our Fasnakyle – Bingally 132kV connection public consultation.



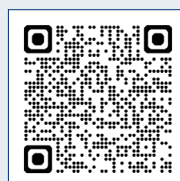
