Construction works have commenced on SSEN Transmission's Killin VISTA project which will see a total of 7.8km of overhead line removed, including 31 steel lattice towers, between Killin substation and Lix Toll.

Safety is always our first priority at SSEN Transmission and with this in mind, we ask that you please remain vigilant of signage or direction around the construction works and do not enter our working areas. Users of the access tracks are asked to obey signage and are reminded that large vehicles and construction traffic are also using the tracks.

## Temporary bridge construction works

Works on the temporary bridge that has been installed across the River Dochart, west of Killin are now complete with the bridge now fully operational for site construction traffic.

The bridge will remain in place for the duration of the works and utilised for construction traffic only.



## Distribution diversion works completed

- The Distribution diversion works around the Killin substation and Church of Scotland grounds (off A827) are now complete. These works were necessary to provide a clear corridor for the cable installation at these locations.
