

Beauly – Blackhillock and Blackhillock – Kintore Reinforcement Projects

Members of the public, landowners and other interested parties are being invited by Scottish Hydro Electric Transmission to attend their consultation events for proposed new overhead line projects.

Scottish Hydro Electric Transmission owns and maintains the electricity transmission network in the north of Scotland. Due to increasing electrical demands on the network, major upgrades will be required between Beauly, Blackhillock, near Keith, and Kintore.

The projects are currently in the early stages of development and the project team would like to consult with landowners, members of the public and other interested parties regarding potential route corridors for new overhead lines.

Members of the Scottish Hydro Electric Transmission project team will be hosting open door events where members of the community can drop in at any time to receive information on the proposal.
