Further to the notice of an application for consent to construct and operate approximately 19km of 275kV Overhead Transmission Line supported by steel lattice towers between the existing Knocknagael Substation and the Tomatin Substation (Garbole) and to construct and operate approximately 4.5km of new 132kv Overhead Transmission Deviation between Tower 127 and Tower 137 on the existing Beauly to Boat of Gartern Overhead Line

Notice is hereby given that **Scottish Hydro Electric Transmission plc** has been granted consent by Scottish Ministers to construct and operate **approximately 19km of 275kV Overhead Transmission Line supported by steel lattice towers between the existing Knocknagael Substation and the Tomatin Substation (Garbole) and to construct and operate approximately 4.5km of new 132kv Overhead Transmission Deviation between Tower 127 and Tower 137 on the existing Beauly to Boat of Gartern Overhead Line**, together with planning permission under section 57(2) of the Town & Country Planning Act (Scotland) 1997.
