



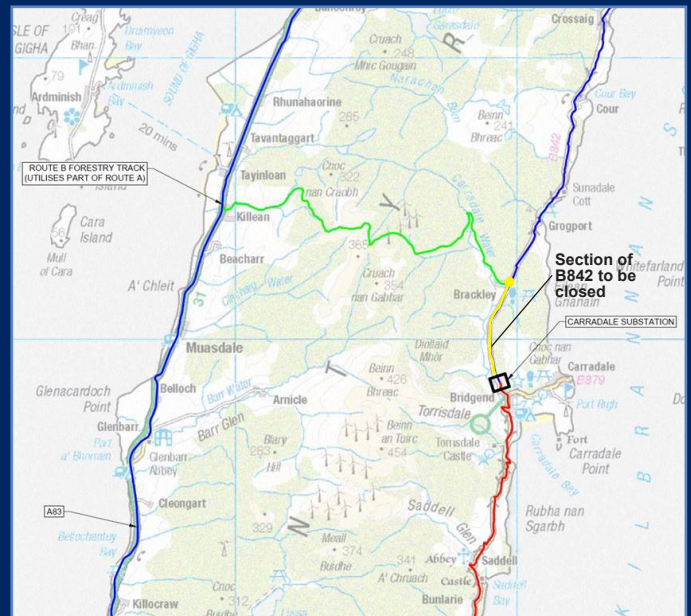
Notice of Road Closure

SSEN Transmission

As part of our ongoing Carradale Substation Project, we will soon be assembling the first transformer on site. The delivery of the transformer will mean a section of the B842 will be closed between approximately 9.30am – 11.00am on Monday 14th December 2020. The section of the B842 which will be closed is between Brackley and the Carradale substation as shown on the adjacent map.

Before travelling on the B842, the vehicle route is from Glasgow to Loch Lomond (A82), north to Crainlarich then Tyndrum, left onto the A85 to Dalmally, left onto A819 to Inveraray, onto A83, through Lochgilphead then Tarbert until it reaches Killean where it will turn left onto the Cross Kintyre Haul Road (XKHR). While travelling on these A roads the vehicle will pull in at intervals to allow traffic to pass. The vehicle will travel over the XKHR from Killean to Brackley on Sunday 13/12/20 and stop overnight at the road end (Brackley), where it will remain until the road closure is in place on the B842 on the morning of Monday 14/12/20.

We anticipate further road closures will be required over the coming months. We will contact you regarding these nearer the time.
