# Shetland Renewable Connections Project Virtual Consultation

**SSEN Transmission invites you to come and share your views with us.**

Scottish and Southern Electricity Networks (SSEN) Transmission are holding four virtual consultation events to present our proposal for generators looking to connect to the GB transmission network. A new transmission network will be created to connect from a number of new windfarms to Kergord Converter Station, which will be a new HVDC Link enabling power generation from Shetland to be transferred to the UK mainland, connecting to a new DC Switching Station at Noss Head in Caithness. We are also contracted to provide a new 132kV Grid Supply Point substation for SHEPD to provide for demand in Shetland.

The virtual consultation events have been designed to be almost as interactive as face to face events, allowing for the presentation of key project information and plans, as well as providing an opportunity to ask questions about the project to team members. Visitors will be able to engage directly with the project team, via a live chat function, where they can ask any questions they might have about the project and share their feedback on the current proposals.
